Timetable for Sunday

Where do I pick up my wristband?

You will be able to collect your entry wrist band for each of your participants on Thursday 28 September and Friday 29 September from one of the three venues below at the specified time.

Thursday 28 September

- McAlpines Mega Mitre 10 Sports Centre – Rangiora 5pm – 8pm
- Sport Canterbury office (Unit B, 1 Brynley Street, Hornby) 9am – 5pm
- The Athletes Foot Papanui (*Northlands Shopping Centre, 55 Main North Road*) 5pm - 9pm

Friday 29 September

- McAlpines Mega Mitre 10 Sports Centre – Rangiora 12pm -6pm
- Sport Canterbury office (Unit B, 1 Brynley Street, Hornby) 9am – 4pm
- The Athletes Foot Papanui (*Northlands Shopping Centre, 55 Main North Road*) 4pm - 8pm

Outside of these times you will need to collect your entry wristband on the day from the registration area between 8.30 - 9.45am. All participants must wear their wristband. Picking this up prior to the day will avoid registration congestion.

If I pick up my wristband do I need to register on the day?

If you collect your registration on either of these days, **you will not be required to register on the day; however you must still attend the race briefing at 9.30am.**

Can I register on the day?

Yes, however we recommend registering online prior to the day to avoid registration congestion.

Is there an on the day registration fee?

Yes on the day registrations are:

Adults: \$20

Child (5-16): \$10

Under 5: Free

CASH ONLY

What are the methods of payment to register?

You can purchase an entry any of the following ways: credit card, direct debit or cash on the day.

Please note: Direct debit payments will close on Wednesday 27 September at 4pm to allow the payment to clear before entries close.

How many participants do I need to have to register as a group?

10 participants or more.

How do I go about registering as a group?

A group registration sheet can be attained from Sport Canterbury by emailing Jules.wilke@sportcanterbury.org.nz Group race packs can be picked up from the Sport Canterbury office between the 25th September and 29th September 8.30am-5pm

Where will the race briefing be held?

In front of the stage at 9:30am

Will a first aid station be available on the day?

St Johns will be present at the event and will be stationed beside the finish line. St John should be the first point of contact if you are feeling unwell or need immediate attention. For anything minor come and see one of the friendly Sport Canterbury staff at the registration tent.

Where will lost children be taken during the event?

If any children are found during the event unattended they will need to be taken to the registration and information tent, from there one of the Sport Canterbury staff will ask the MC to make an announcement on the stage to try and find the parent/guardian.

Anyone under the age of 13 years old must be accompanied by an adult at ALL TIMES during the Hellers Pegasus Fun Run 2017 event.

Can I change the distance I entered?

Yes, you can swap your wristband at the registration tent. One of the registration staff will write your race number on your new wristband. Once you have registered your race number will remain the same regardless of what distance you change to.

What is the course like?

- The 2.5km course is flat and follows the concrete path around the lake.
- The 6km course is a gravel course around the wetlands.
- The 11km course is off road. Majority of the course is tracking through the forest and around the wetlands. The course is slightly soft and sandy in areas with exposed roots - very similar to Bottle Lake Forest.

Is the 11km suitable for a buggy/pram?

- It is a narrow track and does have a stretch of soft sand. We advise against taking buggies, but ultimately the decision is yours. Please be aware of other runners, and start from the back of the group!!!
- 2.5km and 6km are fine to take buggies but remember to start at the back of the pack.

Where is the start line?

- This year the start/finish line will be the same for all distances. The start/finish line will be underneath the blow up arch in front of the swing bridge.

What time is the prize-giving?

Approximately 12.00pm in front of the stage.

How do I know if I have won a spot prize?

If you have won a spot prize you will have a sticker on the back of your certificate. You will receive a certificate as you cross the finish line.

Major Spot Prizes

Major spot prizes will be drawn on stage at the prize giving. Winners must be there to collect.

To enter place your wristband with your name and number in the box at the front of the stage.

Where do I collect my spot prize if I win?

The registration and information tent from 10:30am

Can I take my dog around?

No dogs are allowed on the course

Can my child rollerblade, skate board, bike beside me?

No

Is there anywhere to leave my bag?

There is no designated area to leave your bag. Please leave your valuables at home or locked away in your car.

Do I have to pay for my child if they are in a buggy/pram?

No, children under 5 years old are free to enter.

Is there water on the course?

Yes there is water at the 6.5km point on the 11km course only.

Are there toilets on the course?

Yes there will be a toilet located at the 6.5km mark on the 11km course, we do advise that you go before the event as this area may become congested on the course.

How many people will be participating?

Between 1500-2000

Is there a copy of the course map?

Yes, there is a map of each course next to the registration tent along with a copy of the race rules/guidelines. There is also a copy of the course maps on the website.

Are there prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd?

No this is a fun run!

Do I need to wear my wristband during the event?

Yes

Where do I go after registration?

Make your way to the front of the stage while you wait for the race briefing to begin. There will be a warm up on stage from 9.40am.

Coffee and food vendors will be set up ready to go from 9am.

Do I have to run the course or can I walk it?

You can definitely walk the course but we do ask that you please start at the back of the group.

Will there be a photographer on course?

Yes, there will be a photographer on course. All photos will be posted on [Hellers Pegasus Fun Run](#) facebook page following the event.

Will there be food at the event?

Yes, there will be a wide range of coffee carts and food vendors.

What activities will be at the finish line?

There will be music and entertainment for the children, including a bouncy castle, Skate Skool, Pedalmania and a live band.

Is there car parking available?

Yes, there is a designated parking area, just follow the parking signs and marshals

Do I need to bring cash on the day?

Yes, please bring cash with you on the day if you are planning to register or purchase food/drink or merchandise. There is no guarantee the food vendors will have eftpos facilities available.

If you do need cash there is an ATM located near the Flat White cafe in Pegasus Town.
